Since joining T³ in 2001, Corey has worked on many projects, including developing

curriculum, leading workshops for teachers and administrators, and creating online courses for Tl-Nspire[™] technology.

Corey values the friendships he has made in the T³ family. He also appreciates the chance to "give back" by organizing the Instructor Silent Auction to raise money for the Susan G. Komen Foundation, which has raised about \$50,000 in three years.

Jeff later developed new T³ Institutes including "Connecting Biology and Algebra" and "AgPrep" (now "AgriScience"), which uses the graphing calculator to integrate agricultural science with the more traditional sciences and mathematics. In addition, Jeff has been a member of several writing and planning teams for T³ and Texas Instruments.
